Outreach Committee - Mission

Mission: The Outreach Committee shall establish and maintain an active program for the congregation to reach out to the community with the gospel. It shall also promote the work that the congregation does together with its fellow congregations as a synod.

Duties:

- **Visitor Recognition:** We work on making visitors feel comfortable and wanted at our worship services, follow up local visitors with a home phone call within 36 hours, recognize all visitors with a follow-up note, and process visitors for our prospect list.
- **Prospect List:** We maintain a prospect list of unchurched people in our Oakfield area. It's not unthinkable that we know who all the unchurched people in Oakfield and the surrounding area are and mail them our newsletter and special invitations for Christmas and Easter services. We could also make contact with every new family that moves into our area, invite them to our church and process them for our prospect list.
- **Fellowship Activities:** We organize Easter Breakfast and plan and organize further fellowship activities.
- **New Member Assimilation:** We need to plan and organize ways to integrate new members into the life and work of our congregation. This would include sponsors or mentors to answer questions and inform new members about church cleaning, our offering envelopes and other areas of our church life.
