### WELS KIDS CONNECTION VIDEO

October Episode: This month we see two examples of serving Jesus and loving others through "hands-on" service. First, we watch students from twelve WELS schools—Lutheran elementary schools, Minnesota Valley Lutheran High School, and Martin Luther College—pack 250,000 meals for starving children in Africa. Next, we meet preschool students who shared their love for Jesus with other young children by donating stuffed animals to local police and fire departments.
